Annexation Service Plan <u>Exhibit B</u>

In connection with the annexation of a portion of North State 34 by the City of Oak Ridge, Kaufman County, Texas as described in "Exhibit A", the following service plan is adopted as required by Section 43.056 of the Texas Local Government Code.

The City of Oak Ridge will provide services such as planning, zoning, code enforcement, subdivision regulation, municipal court, construction and building codes and general administration on the effective date of annexation.

Miscellaneous Provisions:

- 1. This service plan is valid for 10 years. Renewal of the service plan at the discretion of the City of Oak Ridge.
- 2. This service plan does not require a uniform level of full municipal services to each area of the City, including the annexed area, if different characteristics of the topography, land use, and population density are considered a sufficient basis for providing different levels of service.
- 3. This service plan shall not be amended unless public hearings are held in accordance with VTCA, Local Government Code, Section 43.052.
- 4. This service plan is adopted as "Exhibit B" to Ordinance 23-08, annexing the property described in "Exhibit A" to the City of Oak Ridge. The City shall provide the area or cause the area to be provided with services in accordance with the service plan.
