City Council Meeting Minutes
May 11, 2026 at 6:00 PM

Item 1 **Call to Order**

Meeting was called to order by Mayor Pro Tem, Jimmy Quick at 6:02 PM on May 11, 2026. Present were Council Members - Rolando Guzman, Janelle Davis, and Scherri Holmes. Chief Bill Weatherly and City Secretary, Karen Stacey were also in attendance. Mayor Paul Huller and Council Member Nena Langford were absent.

Item 2 **The Pledge of Allegiance**

Item 4 **Update on Court Activities for April 2026 – (Bryan White)**

Bryan updated the Council on the activities since March and gave them information on the upcoming court date of May 29, 2026, from 9:30 to 1:00 p.m. There are 61 cases on the docket as of this meeting date.

- Jimmy Quick will check on track loader he may be able to borrow to work on indigent person property clean up.

Item 6 **Discuss, Consider, take Action to Prepare an Amendment to Ordinance 6-11 or 20-11 to ban shipping containers as an outside storage option on any residential lot in the City of Oak Ridge. This does not apply to temporary contractor storage for construction. – (Donnie Spradlin)**

Possibly have a limit on size. Not allow stacking. Maybe require paint to match main color of home. This item is tabled to allow council members to fully read the ordinances that this could be amended to.

Item 7 **Discussion on Police Department - (Chief, Bill Weatherly)**

- Lot of citations have been written this month, PD has been closing out admin tasks to allow more patrol time.
- Officer Marshall is patrolling on his own with backup on duty.
- Captain Clell Murray announced his retirement in July.
- Assistant Chief Loesch and Captain Murray have been working on CAD issues in patrol units. It is a 5G issue. May have to switch from Verizon cradle point to AT&T.

Item 11 Next Council Meeting Date Set for Tuesday, May 26, 2026 City Council Meeting at 6:00 PM, Monday is a Holiday


